Community Impact

66

community members registered to engage in Connectedness Coaching (level 1 training)

213

hours of facilitation was delivered by trained rural community members (peers)

679

community members were reached through services provided, KTE and awareness building initiatives

762

hours of delivered service was provided to Southwestern Ontario community members

- 100% of participants served during this period were **over the age of 55**
- 100% of participants and volunteers were **rurally located**
- 64% of formal / informal volunteers were **over the age of 55**

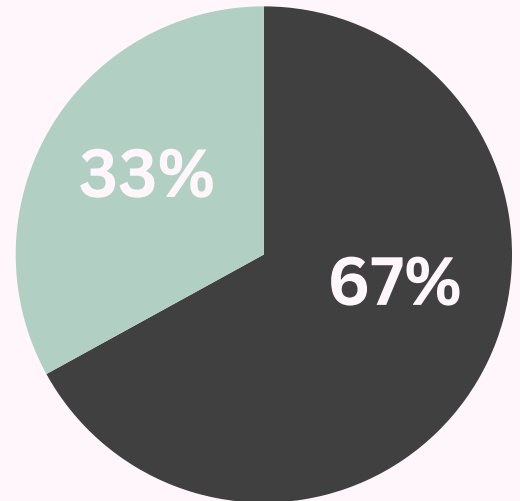

How was Volunteer Education Supported?

67% of Lonely No More's volunteer educational offerings were sponsored through grant funding

33% of Lonely No More's level 1 volunteer educational offerings were sponsored through a fee-for-service delivery*



*fee was sponsored by a not-for-profit that utilized level 1 education to skill enhance their volunteers (cost-sharing)

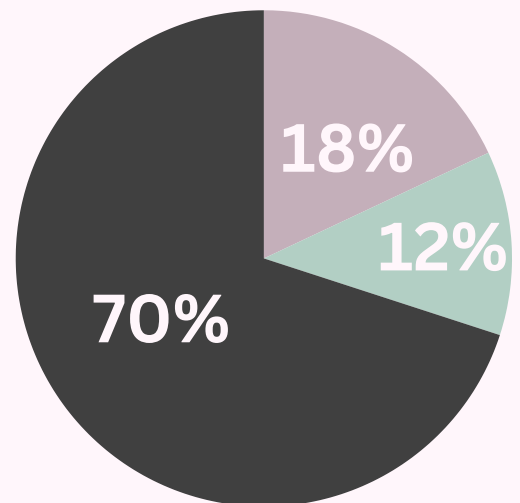

How was Program Delivery Supported?

12% of the units of service delivered during this time period were sponsored through a fee-for-service delivery*

18% were sponsored through grant funding

70% were sponsored through in-kind contributions from for-profit businesses
